1. HEAVEN

Heaven is a free gift.

... the gift of God is eternal life...

Romans 6:23

It is not earned or deserved.

...by grace you have been saved ... it is a gift from God...

Ephesians 2:8-9

Transition:

"This can be understood more clearly when we understand what the bible says about man."

2. MAN

Is a sinner.

... for all have sinned...

Romans 3:23

We have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God - in our thoughts, our words and our actions - and also by the things we have left undone.

God's standard: ... be perfect...

Matthew 5:48

He cannot save himself.

There is a way that seems right to man, but in the end it leads to death.

Proverbs 14:12

The wages of sin is death...

Romans 6:23

Conversation: [Three Sins a Day](#)

Transition:

"This comes into sharper focus when we look at what the bible says about God..."

3. GOD

God is merciful and loves us.

... God so loved the world...

John 3:16

... is... not wanting any to perish...

2 Peter 3:9

He is also just and must punish our sin.

... God is light and in Him there is no darkness at all...

1 John 1:5

... the wages of sin is death...

Romans 6:23 (c.f. Exodus 34:7b)

Transition:

"God solved this problem in the Person of Jesus Christ"

4. JESUS

Jesus is all man and all God.

In the beginning was the Word...and the Word was God... and the Word became flesh.

John 1:1,14

What He did.

God showed His great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners.

Romans 5:8 NLT

He died upon the cross to pay the penalty for sin and rose from the dead to purchase a place for us in heaven.

Transition:

"This free gift is received by faith."

5. FAITH

Faith is not intellectual assent.

Do you still think it's enough just to believe that there is one God?

James 2:18 NLT

Faith is trusting in Jesus Christ alone for eternal life.

... made right in God's sight by faith, we have peace with God because of what Jesus Christ our Lord has done.

Romans 5:1 NLT

Conversation: [The Chair](#)

COMMITMENT

Qualifying Question:

"Does this make sense to you?"

Commitment Question:

"Would you like to receive this gift of eternal life?"

Clarification of Commitment:

"Let me clarify this..."

Stop trusting in yourself and start trusting in Jesus. Invite Jesus into your life as Saviour and Lord. Willingness to repent of your sins and start following Jesus.

Prayer of Commitment:

Pray for the new believer. Pray with the new believer inviting Jesus into their life. Pray for the new believer again. Jesus said *"I assure you, anyone who believes in me has eternal life."*

John 6:47

Welcome the new believer into the family of God!

Friend's Gift

"If a friend gives you a gift, you don't ask them how much it cost or if you can pay half the cost. It is a gift and all you do is receive it. Heaven is God's free gift... isn't that amazing?"

Three Sins a Day

"Sometimes I wonder just how many times a day the average person sins. Just suppose that a person sinned only three times a day, he would have over a 1000 sins per year! If he lived until he was 70 years old, that would be 70,000 sins. Man cannot save himself because God's passing grade is perfection."

Bank Robber

"Suppose I was to rob a bank and was caught on the scene of the crime. A hidden camera takes footage of me doing it and the teller and other eye witnesses identify me as the culprit. When I am brought before the judge he asks, 'How do you plead?' I am guilty and the evidence is undeniable, so I say to him, 'I am guilty, but I have given the money back to the bank and I only did it because I have five children to feed and no money and no job, I promise to never do it again if you will just let me go.' Would the judge be just if he let me go? There would be no justice if our judges behaved like this. God is much more just than any human judge and He simply cannot excuse our sin."

Paid in Full

"Jesus has already paid the penalty for sin and you can have eternal life as a gift: 'the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus.' God offers heaven to us as a free gift."

The Chair

"Let me illustrate. See this chair? Do you believe that this chair exists? Do you believe that it would hold you up? But you see it is not holding you up for a very simple reason; you're not sitting on it. That is the way it is with Jesus, you may believe that He exists, that He is divine, but you must put your faith in Him for this free gift of eternal life."
