John 4:46-54

1. Royal official saw his son's
sickness – **eyes of fear and
worry** (vv 47, 49)

1. The people saw miracles, not
Jesus – **self-centred eyes** (v 48)



What do you see?

John 4:46-54

3. The royal official saw Jesus' authority – **eyes of trust** (v 50)

4. Jesus saw the royal official's son healed – **eyes of faith** (v 50)

5. Royal official and family saw a miracle and believed – **eyes of faith** (v 53)

Faith says – *Believing is Seeing*

I see a seed, you see a harvest


I see the water, you see the wine
