Course Synopses

Creeds and Heresies: The Church Contending for the Faith

Faith that is not tried cannot be proven true. Since the birth of the church our faith has been tested by numerous false teachings seeking to obscure the gospel of Christ. Through these hard-won battles we have today the Creeds of the Church. In this 4-weekly-session we will explore 2 of these Creeds, namely, the Apostles' and Nicene Creeds as well as the key ideas that led to their formulation. At the end of this course attendees should be able to relate the understanding of God in the Creeds to their own Christian lives today.

An Overview of the New Testament

The Overview of the New Testament explores the scenes, backgrounds and main themes of all the New Testament books. At the end of the course, learners will be able to

- Know Jesus' life and ministry on earth through various lenses;
- Understand the different church issues that the apostles had to deal with through their letters; and
- Discover God's enduring purpose and mission for His people in which Jesus laid the foundation and that the apostles gave their lives up for.

Join us for these meaningful sessions of knowing God and Jesus' first generation of disciples.

An Overview of the Old Testament

The course provides a bird's-eye view of the Old Testament books. It introduces learners to the content, context and culture of the four major divisions – Pentateuch, History, Poetry and Prophecy. At the end of this course, learners should be able to

- Describe the key contents of the four major divisions of the Old Testament (OT).
- Explain how each main division relates to the other.
- Chart the key historical events from creation to captivity and restoration
- Apply the basic teachings as they read the Old Testament books

Interpreting the Bible

The course aims to equip learners with the skills to interpret and apply Scriptures. It is suitable for believers who wish to strengthen their Bible study. At the end of the course, learners should be able to

- Understand the rules for interpreting the Scripture
- Develop skills in interpreting biblical texts of different genres (OT narratives, law, poetry, prophecy, wisdom, letters, the Gospels, and parables)
- Apply the Word to their Christian faith and practice.
